FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

DEADLINE TO APPLY: OCTOBER 31, 2017

Colorado Opportunity Scholarship Incentive (COSI): Amount Varies

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Have an Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) of \$13320 or lower as determined by FAFSA application
- Be classified as a Colorado Resident for tuition purposes
- Be classified as a U.S. Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- Be seeking Degree or Certificate completion at CCA

15 to Finish: \$500

- Be within 15 credit hours of program completion at CCA
- Have a cumulative GPA 2.5 GPA or higher
- DACA students are eligible to apply

Sherri Kantor: \$400

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Have a cumulative 2.5 GPA or greater
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours
- Be in a declared Early Childhood Education program of study

Caterpillar – Diesel: \$500

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Must maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA or greater
- Be enrolled in the CCA Diesel Mechanics Program (Wagner students not eligible)

Marie Sanchez: \$1000

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Be entering first or second year of either the Fire Science or EMS program
- Have passed the criminal background check and drug screen at time of enrollment
- Be in good academic standing with a cumulative 2.0 GPA or greater

Mary LeGare: \$485

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Be PELL eligible
- Have a cumulative 2.75 GPA or greater
- Meet general financial aid requirements to include SAP and MAP
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 hours
- Must be a graduate of Gateway or Aurora Central High School

Brakes Plus Education Plus: \$500

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or greater
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours/ semester
- Be a recent HS graduate (within the last 24 months)
- Priority will be given to students of Hispanic Heritage

Freda Roof Memorial: \$500

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Have a cumulative 2.0 GPA or greater

Simard Veterans': \$500

- Must be a Veteran of the US Armed Forces
- Be able to show proof of discharge under any condition other than “dishonorable”
- Be seeking Degree or Certificate completion at CCA
- No longer eligible for, or receiving GI Bill benefits
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester that the scholarship is received
- Have a cumulative 2.5 GPA or greater

CCA Faculty & Staff Choice: \$500

- Have a cumulative 2.5 GPA or greater
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester that the scholarship is received
- DACA students are eligible to apply

Nelnet Foundation Finishers Scholarship: amount varies

- Have a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher
- Must be seeking an Associate's degree and be able to finish their degree by the end of the semester that the student receives this scholarship
- If applicable, applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- DACA students are eligible to apply

Norma Nunez Memorial Scholarship: \$450

- Have a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester that the scholarship is received
- Preference will be given to students with financial need that have 15 or fewer credits remaining in their degree program at CCA
- Must be actively pursuing a defined program of study or certificate
- If applicable, applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- DACA student are eligible to apply

Souleymane and Fumnanya Camara Immigrant Scholarship: \$500

- Must have earned a high school diploma or GED and have (and maintain) a GPA of at least 2.5 or have successfully completed intermediate ESL courses at CCA
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 credit hours per semester that the scholarship is received
- Preference will be given to international, immigrant, or refugee students at CCA
- Must be actively pursuing a defined program of study or certificate
- If applicable, applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Mo Jungck Scholarship: \$500

- Have a completed Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) on file with CCA
- Be Pell Grant eligible
- Must be degree or certificate seeking at CCA
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester that the scholarship is received
